As Augustine wrote many hundreds of years ago, "Our heart is restless until it finds rest in you."

Sadly, in our modern/consumerist lifestyle, we often don't stop long enough to experience the Joy that does not come from circumstances. We don't become rooted. We leave or 'move on' as soon as things gets rocky. Jesus says when things gets rocky, our faith gets strong! If we always bail out, we'll never know faith that is both deep and strong.

Mark 4:37 And there arose a fierce gale of wind, and the waves were breaking over the boat so much that the boat was already filling up. 38 Jesus Himself was in the stern, asleep on the cushion; and they woke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" 39 And He got up and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, "Hush, be still." And the wind died down and it became perfectly calm.

Notice what Jesus says to these frightened men:

40 And He said to them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?"

He is telling them that even in the storm they could have remained calm and trusting. Now they become afraid all over again, but perhaps now they are afraid of the right thing- not a storm, but the Son of the Living God whom the storms obey!

41 They became very much afraid and said to one another, "Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey Him?"

We certainly cannot avoid all the storms of life. Many of them blow up quite unexpectedly. But when they do come, we can trust that He is still in control. In that confidence we can face rather than run from the center of the storm- the person causing us conflict; the money problem; the marital strife...

Now, I cannot tell you exactly what that means for you. I know the areas where I tend to bail, to run instead of facing a problem. Jesus and I am working on it. But your situation is yours. Let him be Lord of your conflict- and with Him at your side, walk confidently toward the center of the storm. And yes, feel free to take an earthly friend along as well!

In the mean time, take the time to get to know this Lord of the sea and wind. Spend time becoming rooted and grounded in His love and strength for you. Give Him more and more opportunity to remind you how awesome he is, and how important and precious you are to Him!
